Monthly Report – March 2018

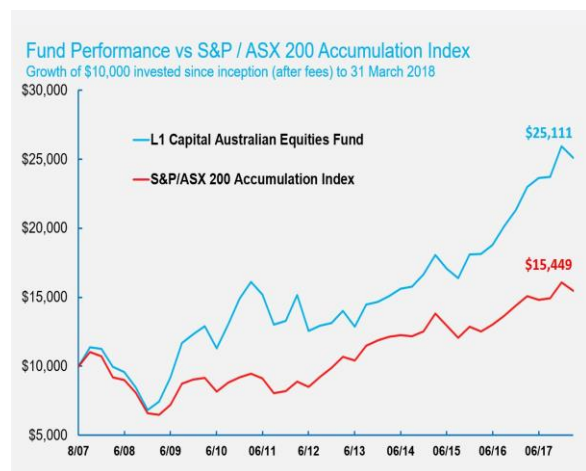
- The L1 Capital Australian Equities Fund delivered a net return of -3.2% for March, outperforming the S&P / ASX200 Accumulation Index by 0.6%.
- Over the past year, the Fund returned 9.2%, exceeding the index by 6.7% (after fees).
- The Fund has been one of the best performing large cap, long only Australian equities funds since its inception, outperforming the S&P / ASX200 Accumulation Index by 4.9% p.a. (after fees).

Global equity markets were battered by a large spike in volatility in March, with the U.S. and China threatening a major trade war and Europe suffering from a hung parliament from the Italian General Election. The ASX200AI fell 3.8%, underperforming major global indices. REITs (+0.1%) were the only sector to sneak into positive territory, whilst Telcos (-6.1%), Financials (-5.8%) and Materials (-4.3%) were the hardest hit.

The Fund generated positive returns from sectors including Telcos, Industrials and Financials, whilst Consumer Discretionary, Real Estate and Consumer Staples detracted from performance. Chorus was the largest contributor to performance in March, rising 11%. The Fund increased its position in February when the shares were sold off on concerns over rising bond yields. Macquarie Atlas again contributed positively, receiving more credit from investors for its fast-growing dividend profile and monopoly asset base.

We believe the unwind of central bank asset purchases is likely to see volatility increase over the next 1-2 years, both for equity markets and the Fund. We remain focused on identifying exceptional stock specific opportunities with asymmetric return profiles. We believe the increase in market volatility will create numerous mispriced stocks that should drive Fund returns over the coming years.

L1 Capital Overview

L1 Capital is a global investment manager with offices in Melbourne, New York and London. The business was established in 2007 is 100% owned by its senior staff, led by founders Raphael Lamm & Mark Landau. The team is committed to offering clients best of breed investment products. L1 Capital manages money for a range of clients including large superannuation funds, insurance companies, endowment funds, private banks, financial planning groups, asset consultants, family offices, high net worth individuals and retail investors.

L1 Capital uses a fundamental, bottom-up research process to identify investments with the potential to provide attractive risk-adjusted returns. The L1 Capital investment approach is largely style-neutral with modest value and contrarian characteristics. The firm launched the L1 Capital Long Short Fund in September 2014. The net return of 33.7% p.a. since inception has been delivered with significantly lower beta and volatility than the market. The Fund has achieved outstanding risk-adjusted returns (maximum drawdown 2.4%, sharpe ratio 3.7, sortino ratio 19.8).
